Articles should not exceed 6000 words including an abstract containing 250 to 300 words. Manuscripts should be submitted as **MS Word** file with **Times New Roman** font (font size 12) and **Harvard Referencing** system should be followed. An article must have a separate title page which will include the name(s) of the author(s), the e-mail address, brief CV of author(s), cell phone number of author(s) and a non-publication declaration of the article. The author(s) will have to submit a similarity check report generated automatically through **Turnitin Software**. The successful author(s) of selected article(s) will be entitled to have remuneration according to the Publication Policy of the Academy.
